Currently, there are **83** undergraduates in the program.

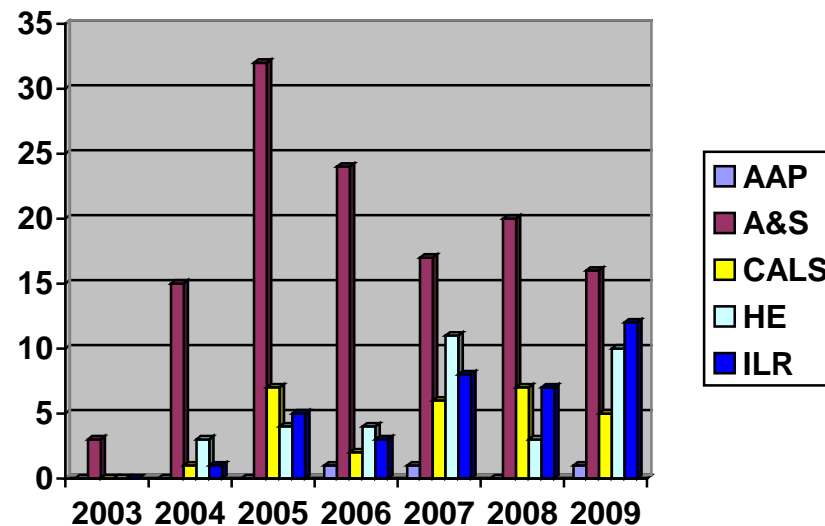
